

Fulbright Specialist Program - Information

The Fulbright Specialist Program offers grants for Australian institutions:

- The grants provide the Specialist with economy class return international air travel to Australia.
- Once Specialists return to the U.S. and submit their final report to the Council for International Exchange of Scholars (<u>CIES</u>), they receive an honorarium of US\$200 for each day they stayed in Australia (minimum 2 weeks, maximum of 6 weeks—42 days).
- Australian host institutions (not Specialists) are required to pay for accommodation, meals and in-country or intra-region travel (see "joint proposals" below).

Australian applicant institutions must identify a specific U.S. Specialist whom they wish to host. For eligible disciplines please see the <u>CIES website</u>. If an application has been successful, the earlier the requested Specialist is registered on the <u>Fulbright Specialist Roster</u> the faster the grant will be processed.

Joint proposals by several Australian institutions, or an Australian institution and a partner university based in the East Asia Pacific region are strongly encouraged. Applications should also include a maximum two-page curriculum vitae of the proposed Specialist and letters of support from the potential host institution(s) in Australia. The whole application must be submitted as a single, text-editable PDF document.

Applications are assessed by an Australian Selection Committee. The <u>Australian-American Fulbright Commission</u> recommends successful applications for award to the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, United States Department of State (<u>ECA</u>), which has the final word.

Note that this program is administered in accordance with the <u>Fulbright Foreign Scholarship</u> <u>Board</u> guidelines, including not to provide "information regarding the reasons for selection or non-selection of applicants for awards" (<u>Policy 145</u>).

Fulbright Specialist Program - Timeline

- 1 July Opening of applications
- 30 September Close of applications
- October Australian selection, recommendations sent to <u>ECA</u>
- November <u>ECA</u>'s final approval to Commission
- December Commission communicates outcome to applicants
- January to December Period during which awarded universities must bring Specialists
