This is Fulbright.

The Fulbright Program is the flagship foreign exchange scholarship program of the United States of America, aimed at increasing binational collaboration, cultural understanding, and the exchange of ideas. Since its establishment, Fulbright has grown to become the largest educational exchange program in the world, operating in over 160 countries. In its seventy-year history, more than 370,000 students, academics, and professionals have received Fulbright Scholarships to study, teach, or conduct research, and promote bilateral collaboration and cultural understanding.

The Fulbright Scholarship in Australia-United States Alliance Studies

In June 2017, Australian Government Minister for Foreign Affairs Julie Bishop and the U.S. Department of State announced the creation of four new, one-time Fulbright Scholarships to commemorate the next 100 years of Australian-American mateship.

The special awards are for two Australian and two U.S. citizens, and aim to advance scholarship in the priority fields of strategic studies, technology and innovation. The awards will promote the exchange of ideas, research collaboration, and cultural understanding between American and Australian scholars as well as the institutions that host them.

Scholarship Eligibility

The Fulbright Scholarships in Australia-United States Alliance Studies are open to applications for both Australian and American candidates who satisfy one of the following criteria:

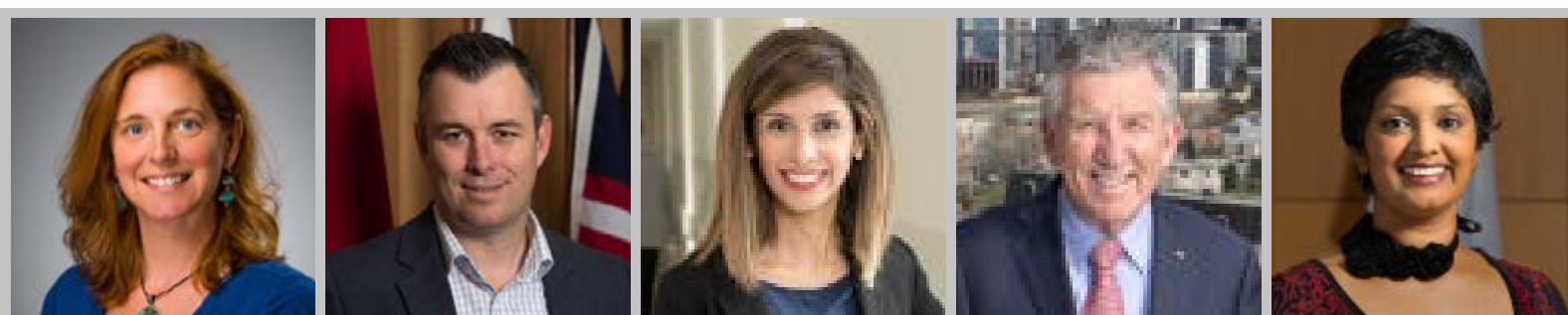
- Academics including PhD candidates, postdoctoral researchers, lecturers, and professors in contemporary scholarship on the Alliance and issues of relevance to it
- Professionals from public and private sectors associated with the Alliance and issues of relevance to it
- Researchers looking into contemporary aspects of the Alliance and broader bilateral relationship (trade/economics/politics) of interest to both alliance partners

It is a condition of the Scholarship that the recipient produces a tangible contribution to contemporary debate in his or her area of specialty in the format of a paper, which will be published with an appropriate accreditation.

Scholarship Benefits

Benefits for the Fulbright Scholarships in Australia-United States Alliance Studies include:

- Monthly stipend - AUD\$5,000+ per month for a maximum of 4 months
- International travel allowance
- Dependent allowance (if eligible)
- Orientation Program and Fulbright Gala Presentation Dinner in Canberra
- Access to a distinguished professional network with U.S. and Australian Fulbright Alumni
- Media support and publicity
- ASPE medical insurance of up to USD\$100,000
